We are very pleased to serve the owners and guests at Timber Creek for the 2024-25 season!

Please be standing outside ready to board the bus as it approaches. Be considerate of others and wait for the next bus if you are not ready when we come by. Adult skis go into the rack on the back of the bus. Bring onboard your snowboard, children's skis and all ski poles.

The 8:30-9:30 am and the 4:00-4:45 pm buses are the busiest of the day. Please be prepared to stand, and if possible, try to avoid those times. Buses may run late during these times. If the morning bus fills up before it gets to your unit, the next bus will start where the first one ended. To find out where your bus is download the **Transit** app on your phone.

Bus Stop Policy For 2024-25 Shuttle Service

The MOOver, with the cooperation and support of the Association, initiated the Timber Creek stop policy in the interest of safety that impacts a small number of units.

The Timber Creek buses don't stop at the corner of Tanglewood and White Oak diagonally across from Unit 1 downhill or uphill to pick up riders.

The same policy applies to the corner of Green Willow and Tanglewood. We no longer pick up riders here downhill on our way out of Timber Creek. We will pick up riders at the intersection of Blue Spruce and Tanglewood going uphill only, but as we pull out of Tanglewood after Unit 161 we will not make any more stops. Thus, Unit 161 on Tanglewood is the bus's last pick up stop before the Sugar House on our way to Mount Snow.
